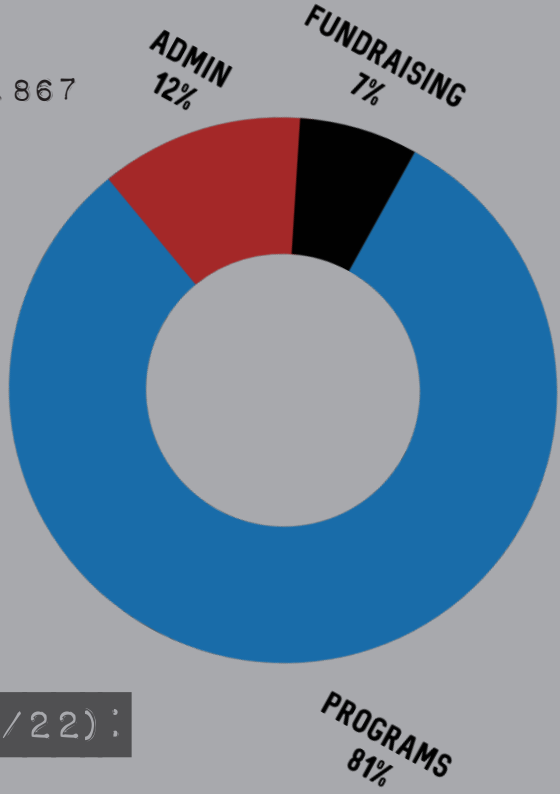

ASSISTANCE OFFERED:

For over 55 years, the 100 Club of Arizona has provided ongoing assistance statewide to public safety agencies, officers, firefighters, and their families through several programs. In addition to those programs, we offer immediate financial aid in cases of:

LINE OF DUTY DEATH:

\$20,000 one-time assistance

ON DUTY DEATH:

\$15,000 one-time assistance

NON-LINE OF DUTY DEATH:

\$10,000 one-time assistance

LINE OF DUTY INJURY:

\$500-\$1500 per month based on injury

ON DUTY INJURY:

\$500 one-time assistance

H.E.R.O.S.:

Up to \$7,500 one-time assistance for life-altering events (loss of spouse or child, terminal illness.)

PEER:

Up to \$5,000 financial assistance for wellness and mental health support
